## **2026 Benefits Premium Updates**

There are health plan premium increases for the 2026 plan year. These increases, along with any benefit changes you made during Annual Enrollment, will be reflected on your December paycheck(s), as premiums are collected one month in advance.

For the 2026 plan year:

- LSU First Health Plan: 7.1% premium increase
- OGB Pelican & Magnolia Plans: 7.75% premium increase
